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# Nature

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- ▶ Animals use natural instincts regardless of consequences related to the action of those instincts.
- ▶ EXAMPLES: Horse runs through fence and causes injury to itself, Geese fly south.
- ▶ Also use their natural instincts to express or suppress physiologic conditions.
- ▶ Question in health or illness? Are an animals symptoms natural instincts to get well or are they really sick.
- ▶ IHT technology helped me to discover

- ▶ George was expressing problems concentrating and it was interrupting his class work which is the future of his education.

### 3 Aspects of Health

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- ▶ Conditioning
- ▶ Healing
- ▶ Symptoms



### 3 Aspects to Health

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- ▶ 1. Conditioning is the body's way of maintaining balance
- ▶ 2. Healing is the body's way of restoring balance
- ▶ 3. Symptoms are the body's way of expression when Conditioning and Healing are decreasing or increasing.

## 3 Aspects of Healing

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- ▶ Balanced Condition, balanced healing, no symptoms = Balanced
- ▶ Decreased Condition, decreased balance, Increased symptoms = Imbalanced
- ▶ Increased Condition, increased healing, decreased symptoms = Restoring Balance

## Symptoms

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- ▶ The Genetic expression of an individual's response to it's environment and the cause and effect that this response creates in the internal homeostasis of this individual.
- ▶ An animal will express these symptoms only when the internal imbalance has been sustained long enough to override the instinctual nature to suppress it.
- ▶ By that time, temporary or permanent damage will result and lead to chronic disease processes.

## What, Where, Why, How?

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- ▶ Intricate series of questions to determine the true nature of the disease process within the INDIVIDUAL patient.

## Traditional diagnostics and therapy

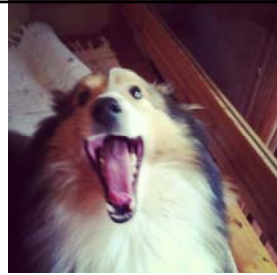
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- ▶ Traditional diagnostics compares individual patient to the group. Bell curve.
- ▶ Normal animals can have abnormal blood work and abnormal animals can have normal bloodwork.
- ▶ Gives us the What and Where of disease process, but not always and not Why
- ▶ Focuses on one aspect of the presentation of symptoms which can often lead to chronic disease problems.
- ▶ Therapy focuses on suppressing symptoms with long term side effects.
- ▶ What if the patient is trying to heal? IHT will determine WHY



## Healing



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- ▶ May be part of the symptoms
- ▶ Decreased when patient has reduced internal balance
- ▶ Must be increased through alternative therapies until restoration of balance is achieved. ie acupuncture, herbs, homeopathy, etc

## Conditioning

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- ▶ Brings us to the IHT analysis
- ▶ Determines WHY the patient has the diagnosis or the symptoms
- ▶ Determines if patient is sensitive to environment
- ▶ Customizes to the individual patient

## IHT Analysis

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- ▶ Base point reading determines stress or weakness out of 30 different balance points within the body.

## Sensitivities

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- ▶ Sensitivities are run to determine if the patient is reacting to exterior forces that become absorbed or incorporated into the body. Once incorporated, will be inactivated and stored in connective tissue or fat by the immune system or another option may be to burn off through inflammation. This causes problems.

- ▶ Responded to pain relief but progressively worse and increasing intensity with each episode to the point of possible surgery if it continued.



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## What, where, why, how

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- ▶ What = gastrointestinal disease
- ▶ Where = lower gastrointestinal tract
- ▶ Symptom = periodic low gastrointestinal pain
- ▶ Decreased healing and control of the periodic lower gastrointestinal disturbance = Qi stagnation of lower intestinal tract
- ▶ Decreased Condition that leads to the decrease healing of the periodic lower urinary tract = run IHT test and sensitivities to determine WHY.

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## Therapy for Louie

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- ▶ Symptoms = Banamine to control periodic colic
- ▶ Healing = Happy Earth Chinese herbal to support the healing process until balanced
- ▶ Conditioning= Drainpar drops which is base homeopathic remedy focused infused with bottom 3 weaknesses to customize the conditioning therapy. 15 drops per day for two months.
- ▶ Sensitivities indicated allergies to Flaxseed, Corn, and various sweeteners, that he had been receiving in his feed at the barn he was boarding at. We switched to whole oats.

## End result

- ▶ 2 Months balanced patient
- ▶ No further colic since 2013
- ▶ He was fed sweet feed with flaxseed and corn by accident a few times afterwards and did not lead to colic = resolution
- ▶ Balanced patient = Healing = resolved symptoms.

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- ▶ What, where, why, how
- ▶ Symptoms are the expression not the root
- ▶ Conditioning and balanced healing is the road to health restoration
- ▶ IHT is the best way to get to the root
- ▶ Versatile with other modes of therapy
- ▶ IHT suites any mode of healing you practice
- ▶ IHT should be in every clinic and should be part of every diagnostic and treatment plan.

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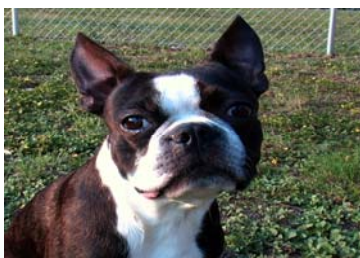

## Result

- ▶ 3 acupuncture treatments later spaced 3 weeks apart plus infused hemp oil resulted in full use of back legs
- ▶ Eliminated expensive MRI and surgery with average cost of \$7500
- ▶ Full recovery without masking symptoms
- ▶ Lasting results

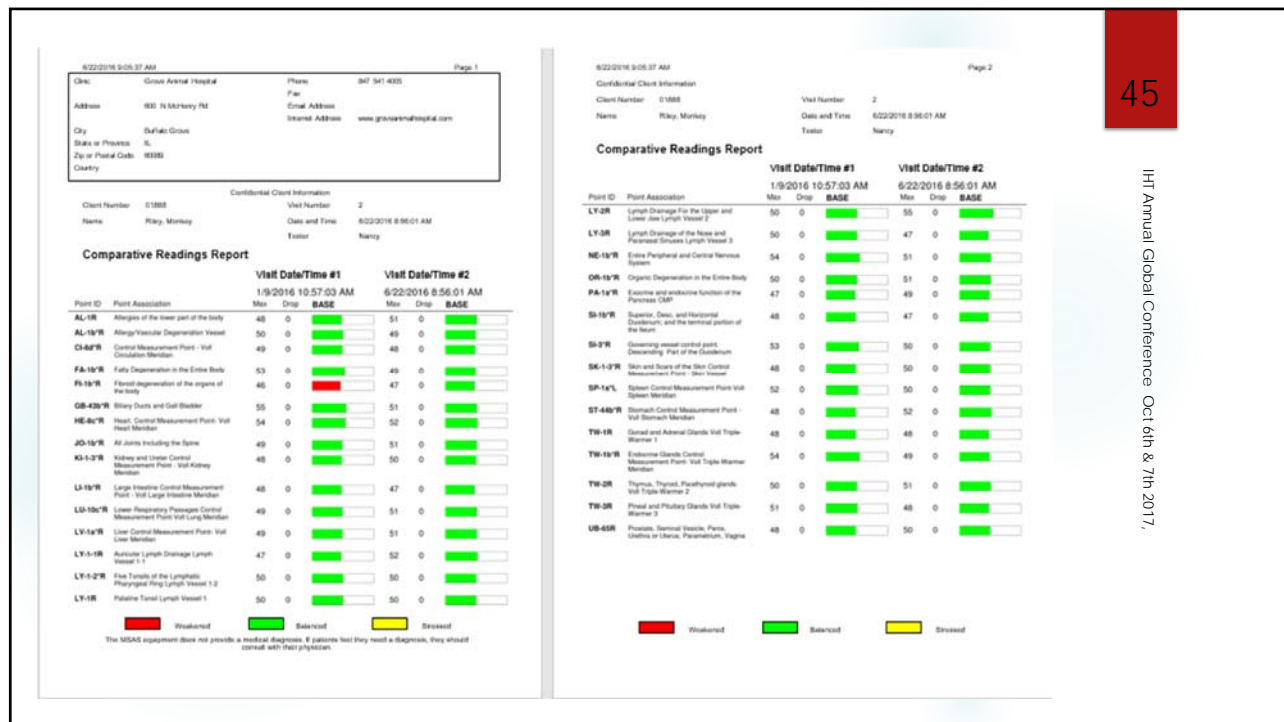
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# Base point reading

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## Treatment

- ▶ Infusion for Gall bladder using Hemp Oil
- ▶ Started with 5 drops daily
- ▶ Cold laser to GB Back Shu Point
- ▶ Release bladder without emergency catheterization

## Result

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- ▶ Full balance after 5 months as indicated by second test
- ▶ No further urinary tract problems
- ▶ Saved owner average cost of \$1000.00 for emergency treatment
- ▶ Many referrals for clinic
